1	Simple Present Tense	Subject + Verb (v1) + es/es	She reads book in library.
2	Present Continuous Tense	Subject + is/am/are + Verb(+ing)	I am studying in a high school.
3	Present Perfect Tense	Subject + Has/have + Verb (v3)	He has made this colorful chart.
4	Present Perfect Continuous Tense	Subject + Has/have + been + Verb(+ing)+ since/for	She has been working there since 2017.
5	Simple Past Tense	Subject + Verb (v2) or irregular verb	He completed the assignment.
6	Past Continuous Tense	Subject + was/were + Verb(+ing)	He was reading the book.
7	Past Perfect Tense	Subject + had + Verb (v3)	I had finished my home work.
8	Past Perfect Continuous Tense	Subject + had + been + Verb(+ing)	I had been playing football since morning.

9	Simple Future Tense	Subject+ will/shall+ verb(v1)	I shall go to park for a walk.
10	Future Continuous Tense	Subject + will/shall be + verb(+ing)	He will be playing football.
11	Future Perfect Tense	Subject + will have + verb(v3)	He will have played football.
12	Future Perfect Continuous Tense	Subject + will have been + verb(+ing)	He will have been watching the TV for fifty minutes.
13	Past Future Tense	Subject + would + verb (v1)	I told that I would leave in one hour.
14	Past Future Continuous Tense	Subj + should/would be + Verb(+ing)	I told that I would be doing my work all the day long.
15	Past Future Perfect Tense	Subj.+ should / would have + Verb(v3)	She said that she would have done her work.
16	Past Future Perfect Continuous Tense	Subject + would have been + Verb(+ing)	He said that I should have been working here for two hours by that time.
